Students enjoyed reflecting on what makes Singapore unique while connecting these ideas to their own experiences.

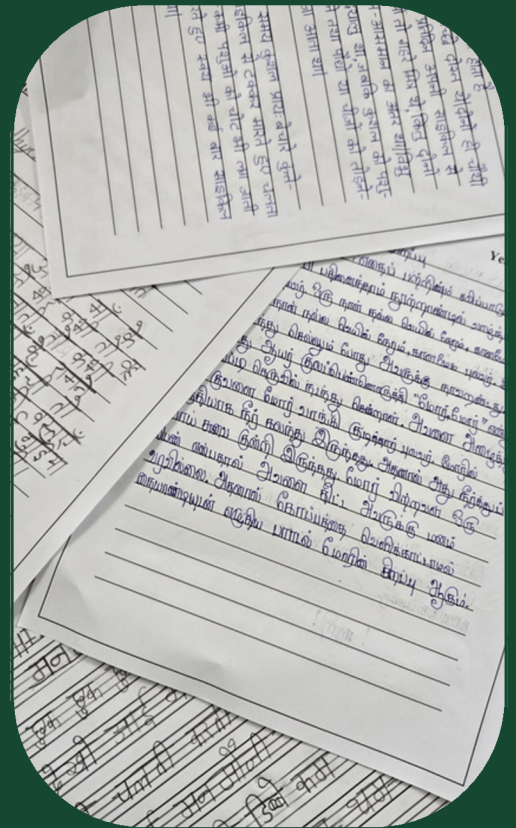
It was an inspiring and meaningful outing that deepened their appreciation for the country's heritage.
