Student Speaker FOSSASIA Summit 2026

We are proud to celebrate **Kannan Murugapandian, a 16-year-old student of DPS International School, who delivered a Lightning Talk at the FOSSASIA Summit 2026** in Bangkok on 9 March 2026, one of Asia's largest open-source technology conferences.

In his talk, "Beyond One-Size-Fits-All: Democratizing Personalized Learning with Open Source AI," Kannan addressed a challenge education has faced for centuries- the trilemma of quality, scale, and personalization.

An open-source developer and competitive programmer, **Kannan has built several innovative projects including LegisAI, an automated legal reasoning system,** and lightweight AI architectures such as MittenAI. His achievements include a Third Degree Diploma at the NSUCRYPTO International Olympiad in Cryptography, a medal at the Singapore National Olympiad in Informatics (NOI), and a Silver Medal at the Singapore Informatics League (SIL). He is passionate about developing scalable AI solutions for real-world challenges, particularly in education.
