### PARENTS' GUIDELINES

Our Extra-Curricular Activities (ECA) programme for Academic Year 2026-27 offers a structured and progressive platform for students to explore their interests beyond the classroom. Designed to nurture talent, leadership, creativity, and teamwork, our diverse range of activities ensures holistic development for every learner.

#### Key Points:

- It is mandatory for students to participate in one ECA which will run for an academic year.
- Uniform & Equipment: Students must attend ECAs in the required uniform and bring necessary gear. For ECAs without a specific uniform, the P.E. uniform is required.
- Competitions: Participation in competitions is part of the program. Parents must arrange pick-up for events outside school hours.
- ECA Changes: Changes are only allowed within the first month of the academic year. To request a change, email [eca@dps.edu.sg](mailto:eca@dps.edu.sg) with the student's name, class, current ECA, preferred ECA, and reason for the change.

#### Fees for Changes:

- First Change: S\$50 admin fee
- Second Change: S\$100 admin fee
- Changes are assessed on a case-by-case basis.

#### Additional Info:

- A minimum of 10 students is required for an ECA. If not met, students will be placed in their second preference.
- Taekwondo: Separate uniform and grading fees.
- Robotics: Kit fee.
- Inline Skating: Students must purchase their own equipment as per coach instructions.
- Competitions: Costs for interschool events are borne by parents.

## ECA 2026-27

### INLINE SKATING

A fun and fitness-oriented activity that builds coordination, balance, and endurance through guided skating techniques.

## FOR GRADE 1 TO 9

### MUSIC (VOCALS)

An introduction to traditional South Indian vocal music, focusing on ragas, talas, and basic Carnatic techniques. Students will develop vocal skills, learn classical compositions, and gain an understanding of the rich cultural heritage of Carnatic music through guided practice and performance.

- Open to Grades 1 to 6

### RHYTHMIC GYMNASTICS

A graceful combination of dance and gymnastics using ribbons, hoops, and balls to enhance flexibility, strength, and artistic expression.

- Open to Grades 2 to 6

### MUSIC (KEYBOARD)

Provides a comprehensive foundation for beginner students. It combines music theory, keyboard technique, song application, and creativity development in a progressive format.

- Open to Grades 3 to 9

### BASKETBALL

The ECA Basketball class focuses on developing fundamental skills such as dribbling, shooting, and teamwork, while fostering fitness, coordination, and sportsmanship. Students will participate in drills and friendly matches to enhance their game.

### ROBOTICS & CODING

An innovative programme introducing students to coding, design, and problem-solving through hands-on robotics projects and challenges.

### CHESS

Teaches students strategic thinking, problem-solving, and concentration through the game of chess. Students will learn opening strategies, tactics, and endgames, while enhancing their critical thinking skills in a fun and competitive environment.
